








The chart illustrates the percentage of respondents. Approx. 70% students speak that the Office Staff are cooperative in nature.



The various graphs present the different views expressed by present students and alumni in regard to their perception of quality in teaching learning, curriculum, infrastructure and student support.





Action Taken Report


