It's a pride to announce that about **46 scholars** from graduate and post-graduate have received MWF scholarship since 2009 till date. Out of which 40 are female and attained higher education and created a bench mark in their respective fields and the success stories of **Ms. Dipali Lande**, Ms. Suvarna Bokale, Ms. Rahatafroj Kadir Shaikh, Ms Aishwarya Shelke, Mr. Amar Belkhede and Mr. Chandrakant Habde, Ms. Komal Bhambe are enclosed within. In view of the socio-cultural context, where financially
