12. Others (Specify) : Watching a movie that has been read as text in the class is informative, fun; also gives a better understanding of the text, and the socio-economic and political condition of that age.



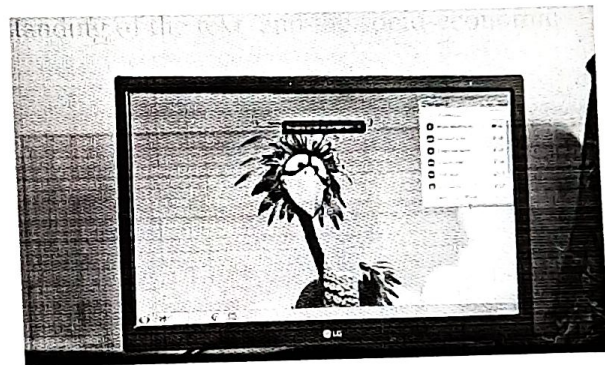
Online Movie Screening for FYBA - Engine Trouble from Malgudi Days by R. K. Narayan



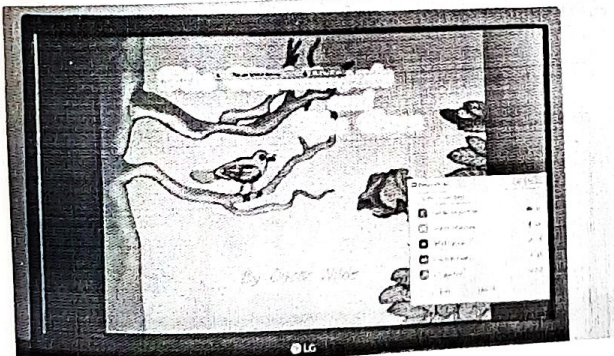
Malgudi Days : As a cultural display of the age and details of the village fair of that time



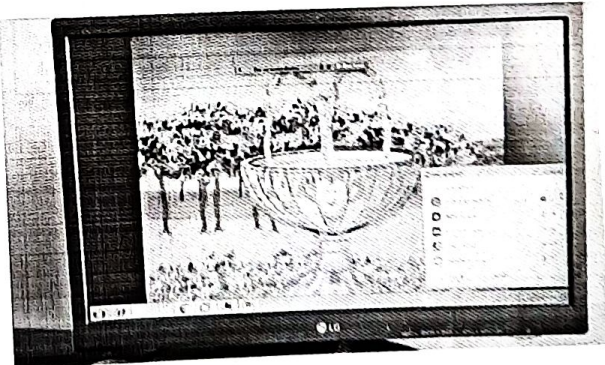
Interview of Sudha Murthy by Shashi Tharoor on the use of simple Indian English in Murthy's stories

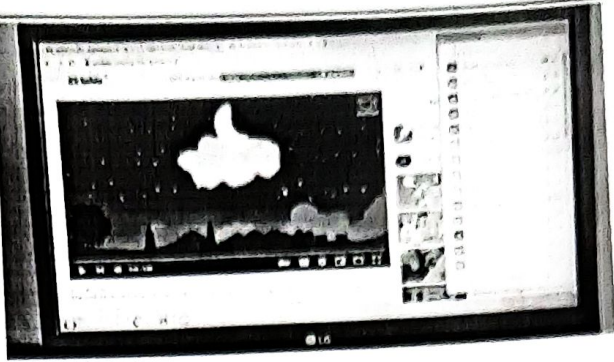
Screening of the animation movie on the short story 'The Nightingale and the Rose' for FYBCom students



The fable of the Garden in the story 'The Nightingale and the Rose' understood via animation



